RESEARCH INTERESTS

My principal research interests lie in far-right research at the intersection of global climate governance. I am interested in how far-right actors make sense of the climate crisis, how their increasing influence affects global climate governance, and how this affects their transnational cooperation.

In my PhD thesis, I explore the climate policy preferences of far-right members of the European Parliament. Focusing on their everyday practices, I aim to understand how beliefs on climate policy develop and become dominant, which power structures are at play and how far-right MEPs interact with each other across borders and convictions.

As a research associate at the FARRIO project, I analyse far-right contestations of international organisations in global climate governance, focusing on UNFCCC and the EU. The aim is to identify far-right actors and their strategies and explore international organisations' reactions to such challenges.
